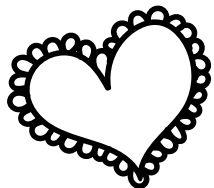

The world has a shortage of rose colored glasses right now! You can help by making yours at home. Share with family and friends. We'll tell you how...

- Take two clean toilet paper rolls, and decorate them with crayons, markers, paint or whatever you like. Set them aside to dry.
- Print this template and trace the solid lines of the two circles onto clear plastic. We used the clean, plastic top of a take-out container, but any clear plastic will do.
- Color the plastic circles using markers with roses colors (red or pink) or whatever colors you wish. You can even make rainbow glasses. We found sharpie markers work best. Blend colors or remove marker strokes with a cotton swab and nail polish remover if you like.
- Carefully cut out the plastic circles and the short tab lines. Fold along dotted lines.
- Place glue on the folded tabs and carefully slide one circle into one end of the toilet paper roll. Hold or paper clip in place until dry. Repeat for the other roll.
- With both plastic circles facing up, use paper, string, or fabric to wrap and hold the two toilet paper rolls together.
